



Kelley Fox Wines Freedom Hill Vineyard Pinot Blanc 2024

This wine was produced from the storied Freedom Hill Vineyard in Dallas (bordering the Eola-Hills A.V.A.) and was planted, owned, and farmed by the Dusschee family. The soil here is Bellpine, a marine sedimentary silt clay loam that is well-drained. The Pinot blanc was whole cluster-pressed after picking. It settled in tank for a couple of days before racking and after primary, it was racked into neutral French oak barrels for élevage until bottling. This wine is bone-dry and ML-complete. The colour is pale spun-gold and it's brilliantly transparent in the glass. After-the-rain minerality, juicy white peaches, the tiniest hint of sweet, warm baking spices and vanilla begin in the nose and continue through to the finish. The Freedom Hill is very detailed and smoothly textured. Bright acidity supports the fruit in the background. A serious and beautiful Pinot blanc. It's Pinot, after all.
