



Kelley Fox Wines Durant Vineyard Pinot Noir 2024

I'm excited to offer you my third bottling of Durant Vineyard Pinot Noir! This is old vine, self-rooted Pommard planted in 1974 and 1984 from the South Bishop Block. Historical Dundee Hills fruit with all of the inimitable character that comes with it.

The Durant 2024 is a shining, transparent, and faceted youthful pure red. It has the classic Dundee Hills nose of perfectly ripe Hood strawberries and subtle warm spices, soft minerals, and a hint of sassafras. The mouth is full of rich, red strawberries with the classic Durant sappiness and gorgeous weight. The finish is fine and utterly delicious. The Durant has the energy of early summer and is full of life. As I write every year, there should be a tarot card with a picture of this early summer queen all surrounded by Oregon strawberries and bluebird skies with puffy clouds and the feeling of building abundance.

Picking Date: 30 September 2024 (from the Bishop Block Pommard franc de pied vines planted in 1973 and 1984)

Barrels: neutral Burgundy barrels (228L) made from tight-grain French forests

Bottling Date: 10 July 2025
