



Kelley Fox Wines Freedom Hill Vineyard Chardonnay 2024

A couple of years ago, my beloved importers in Japan asked me if/when I would produce a single vineyard bottling of my Freedom Hill Vineyard Chardonnay. I was waiting for the vines to mature a bit longer, but this question led to me thinking that I would see how the vines and fruit looked during growing season and harvest to decide. They were ready. This is my first bottling of Freedom Hill Vineyard Chardonnay.

This wine is eye-catchingly transparent (seems contradictory, but still) and is a brilliant light gold in colour. The nose is filled with creamy mixed citrus and pear, a hint of brioche, powdery minerals and subtle spices. The mouth is much the same, and very fine with good structure and tension. The finish is long and detailed. At the time I wrote these notes (February 2026), this wine needs time. I can't wait.
